

## Photos for the Ems Valley U3A web site

We love having photos sent to the U3A Web site to show what groups are up to.

There is no limit to the number of photos you can send in. However it would be useful to know what the photo is of (maybe write a suitable short caption), who took and the photo and where. Captions and/or photographer's name will be included with the enlarged image (unless you tell me otherwise).

If you are sending more than one photo and would like them in a certain order you can either send a list showing the order or you could re-name the file with 1, 2 or 3 in front of the name.

All photos are resized to suit the web site. Generally speaking they are resized to 600pixels high (top to bottom) no matter whether they are upright or landscape. If a photo arrives and is smaller than 600pixels high it is left unchanged as I assume you want it that size and, if I resized the photo, it might suffer from pixilation. If you resize photos please make sure they are saved in RBG and preferably as JPG files. If I have to convert files there may be some change to the quality.

Photos taken on a digital camera or on a phone are acceptable.

Please send your photos by email, nor more than 4 at a time. So send multiple emails naming them the same in the subject line but numbering them <subject>1, <subject2> etc. etc.

Please remember the photo is the copyright of the photographer and it is assumed the photographer has any necessary permissions for the subject. This is doubly important if children are included in the photos.
